		Mitigation Step: "Conduct rigorous post-election audits....crucial to detect attacks where the vulnerabilities are exploited such that a barcode is manipulated to be tabulated inconsistently with the human-readable portion of the paper ballot. (NOTE: ImageCast X provides the configuration option to produce ballots that do not print barcodes for tabulation.)"
